

Leafy Luminary

This craft project provides the opportunity to help teach the different kinds of trees to your children by having them identify the shapes of the leaves associated to each one. This project requires only two steps but the results are quite beautiful and can make a wonderful centerpiece or if you make several you could even potentially hang them along a line of string for decorative purposes.

Items you need

- 1. Brown Paper bag with top folded down twice
- 2. Leaves
- 3. An electric light of some sort, string lights or the small electric candles work very well



DIRECTIONS:

Step 1.

Place glue on the underside of the dry leaves. Use dry leaves if possible so that they do not change shape or curl over time and you.

Step 2.

Place the leaves to the inner sides of the bag, leave enough space between the leaves to let their distinct shadows show through.





Step 3.

Carefully place the electric light in (do not use a candle or anything with an open flame because every content of this project within the close quarters is flammable and thus a fire hazard) in so as not to rip off the leaves. You now have a luminary bag that is perfect for indoor or outdoor decoration to commemorate your time spent at Woodlands Trail.
