#### **Citizen Scientists Monitor Forest Health at Woodlands Preserve**

If you have been to Woodlands Preserve during the past couple of months, you may have noticed more stations like the one pictured springing up in different parts of the property. These are called Chronolog stations and were funded by a grant from TC Energy.

The stations are located in areas of Woodlands Preserve that are undergoing or about to undergo restoration. This is a crowd-sourced time-lapse photo project that helps track restoration progress.
